A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE GOOGLE FIBER FOR COMMUNITIES INITIATIVE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO JOIN WITH OTHER COMMUNITIES IN OUR REGION IN A JOINT RESPONSE TO THE GOOGLE REQUEST FOR INFORMATION.

WHEREAS, the communities that are part of the Miami Valley Communications Council and Beavercreek, Dayton, Fairborn and Riverside have agreed to collaborate on a single regional response to the Google Request for Information (RFI), and

WHEREAS, Technology First is the agreed upon Project Manager to create a single regional response to the Google RFI, and

WHEREAS, the response must be provided to Google by March 26, 2010, and

WHEREAS, this represents an excellent economic development opportunity for our region.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The City Council hereby supports the regional application for the Google Fiber for Communities initiative.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to join with the aforementioned communities in gathering and submitting such information to Technology First as is necessary to create a single regional response to the Google RFI.

Section 3. If required by Google, the City Manager is authorized to participate in, and agree to, the selection of one government employee from among the aforementioned communities to be the post RFI submission single government point of contact with Google to respond to Google inquiries and requirements.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
