**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR NEW FREEDOM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION TO THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION FOR PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS BENEFITING AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES.**

WHEREAS, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) has solicited local government entities and transit agencies to submit new transportation projects and/or services for funding consideration in the FY 2009-2010 New Freedom Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville has committed to a timely project development schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section I. That the City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to submit an application for 2009-2010 New Freedom funding consideration from the Federal Transit Administration for the following transportation infrastructure project to benefit Americans with Disabilities:

RTA Bus Stop Accessibility Project to construct concrete bus pads between sidewalks and curbs at locations identified by Greater Dayton RTA.

Section II. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
