A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID FOR A UTILITY TRUCK WITH AN AERIAL DEVICE (PROJECT VE-7-10-4) AS SUBMITTED BY UTILITY TRUCK EQUIPMENT, INC., OF CIRCLEVILLE, OHIO, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville advertised for bidders for a new utility truck with aerial device pursuant to specifications prepared by the City, and

WHEREAS, Utility Truck Equipment, Inc., of Circleville, Ohio, was the low and best bidder.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by Utility Truck Equipment, Inc., for the sale of a utility truck with an aerial device to the City of Centerville for a bid price of \$90,575.00, or a final price of \$80,575.00 if the trade-in option is exercised, is hereby accepted, a copy of which is attached hereto, incorporated herein and marked Exhibit "A", and

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to execute a contract with Utility Truck Equipment, Inc., for the purchase of a utility truck with an aerial device as stated above, and

Section 3. That this resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.

RE: Bid for Utility Truck with Aerial Device

Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with specifications provided by the City of Centerville, it is our pleasure to enclose our proposal for a Versalift SST-40-EIH aerial tower with a Brand FX BFXB84DLS fiberglass service body mounted on a 2011 Ford F550 4x2 chassis. Please note the following clarifications, deviations, and exceptions as they pertain specifically to our offering for this equipment:

- Delivery is approximately 120-180 days after receipt of order. Delivery should be no problem by 6/6/2011 for an order received prior to 12/15/2010.
- Service and maintenance on the vocational equipment is available at our U.S. Route 23 facility in Circleville, Ohio.
- The standard Ford warranty will be provided for the Ford F550 chassis. Both the aerial tower and the service body are standard with 12 month limited warranties. The chassis warranty will be provided by your local Ford dealer; the City of Centerville will be responsible for transportation to and from this facility. Warranty on the vocational equipment includes one (1) service call to your facility after delivery at no charge. The City of Centerville will be responsible for road service charges to your facility, or transport to and from our facility, for warranty service required after this initial service call.
- Chassis cab will be a 2011 Ford F550 4x2, 84" C.A., 18,000# GVWR. The chassis will be furnished in standard Ford Oxford white.
- Automatic circuit breakers are not available on the Ford chassis.
- Noise suppression equipment is not available on the Ford chassis.
- Engine shut-down system is not available on the Ford chassis.
- Hydraulic power will be supplied by an engine mounted hydraulic clutch pump assembly. This is required to provide operation utilizing the aerial tower two speed throttle system, permitting tower operation at engine idle.
- Unit will be furnished with a single hydraulic tool circuit at the basket with connections on outside of control cover.


- Body inner floor opening will be 58" wide.
- Rear tail lights will be rubber grommet mounted and will not have guards.
- Front amber LED warning lights will be grille mounted, not mounted inside chassis lenses.
- Body cargo floor and tailshelf will be finished manufacturer's standard black. Cargo and tailshelf floors will be finished in a non-skid black paint.
- Body will be furnished with clear vinyl front rock guards.
- Body will be furnished with a 30" rear tailshelf and a divided gripstrut ICC bumper. The bumper extends slightly beyond the rear edge of the tailshelf. Includes vise bracket as specified.
- Body lighting connections are in a weatherproof junction box at rear under body. All UTE wiring will be run in split plastic loom and secured at regular intervals. Our standard wiring installation will be utilized with crimp style connectors and heat shrink as appropriate. Scotch lock connectors will not be used.
- Aerial tower upper controls at platform will feature a single handle control that operates outer boom elevation, extension, and turret rotation. A separate control lever is furnished for lower boom elevation.
- Aerial tower lower controls are located on the curbside of the turret with the booms stowed.
- Aerial tower turret / pedestal will mount just forward of rear axle centerline in the center of the cargo area. The pedestal on the optional SST37 unit mounts at the front of the body cargo area.
- Terms: Net 10 days.

- SST-37-EIH aerial tower in lieu of SST-40-EIH.....DEDUCT.....(\$1500.00).
- Front and rear axle torsion bars for stability in addition to outriggers; will reduce platform capacity to 350#.....ADD.....\$3250.00.
- 24" x 30" enclosed platform with integral step and cover.....ADD.....\$275.00.
- 7 year, 200,000 mile Ford Plus warranty.....ADD.....\$2350.00.
