A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACTION OF THE
CITY MANAGER IN APPLYING FOR FUNDING FROM
THE GREATER DAYTON REGIONAL TRANSIT
AUTHORITY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A GAZEBO
BUS STOP SHELTER ALONG LOOP ROAD NORTH OF
ALEX-BELL ROAD IN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, the Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority made funds available to jurisdictions to implement transit-related capital projects and to promote transit-related community development through an RTA Community Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville desired to apply in a timely manner for funds, not to exceed \$18,900.00, for a gazebo bus stop shelter on the north side of the intersection of Loop Road and Alex-Bell Road in the City of Centerville.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the action of the City Manager in submitting a grant application, on behalf of the City of Centerville with the Greater Dayton Regional Transit Authority for funds not to exceed \$18,900.00 for a bus stop gazebo at the intersection of Loop Road and Alex-Bell Road, is hereby ratified.
