RESOLUTION NO. <u>6-09</u> CITY OF CENTERVILLE. OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Douglas Cline ON THE 16th DAY OF February, 2008.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACTIONS OF THE CITY MANAGER IN REGARDS TO AMENDING A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH THE OBERER COMPANIES TO EFFECT THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, Council has previously determined that it would be in the best interest of its citizens to sell property located in the City of Centerville to Oberer Companies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville by Resolution No. 42-07 authorized and directed the City Manager to take all steps and execute a Letter of Intent to lead to negotiation of a Purchase Agreement with the Oberer Companies; and

WHEREAS, a Purchase Agreement with Oberer Construction Managers Limited was entered into on or about May 21, 2008, which followed the terms of the Letter of Intent; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment to Purchase Agreement was entered into on or about November 21, 2008, which extended the due diligence period; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it would be best to again amend that Agreement to extend the due diligence period further; and

WHEREAS, Council has the power to enter into such Real Property Purchase Agreement by virtue of its Charter and the provisions of Article VIII, Section 16 and Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to sign a Second Amendment to the Purchase Agreement with Oberer that contains terms as set forth in Section 2, that are acceptable to the City Manager and the Municipal Attorney.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the terms of the amendment should substantially require and/or allow the following:

1. An extension of the Due Diligence Period set forth in Section 4(a) of the Purchase Agreement for an additional one hundred and

eighty (180) days up to and including August 14, 2009.

2. That as a result of this extension of the Due Diligence Period, the closing date for the Phase I Closing shall be no later than September 13, 2009, or such earlier date parties may agree. This extension shall not affect the date of the Phase II Closing as provided in Section 9 of the Purchase Agreement.

3. As an additional condition for this Second Amendment, terms regarding assignment, ownership and/or completion of any engineering work, environment reports, field work, EPA or Army Corps permits and similar items will need to be agreed upon as determined to be in the City's best interests.
