RESOLUTION NO. 17-09 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER <u>Faul Gresham</u> ON THE 1/4 DAY OF <u>May</u>, 2009.

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF DANIS BUILDING CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE OF THE PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY AND AT THE GUARANTEED MAXIMUM PRICE NOT TO EXCEED FIVE MILLION, EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,800,000.00).

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville, in Resolution No. 45-06, entered into a contract ("Agreement") with DANIS Building Construction Company ("DANIS"), whereby DANIS agreed to serve as construction manager for the construction of a new public works facility; and

WHEREAS, DANIS has informed the City Manager and the Director of Public Works that DANIS prepared bid specifications for various portions of the contract, solicited bids for subcontractors, and has opened and analyzed the bids pursuant to the terms of the Agreement and applicable law; and

WHEREAS, DANIS has provided a bid package summary for the various projects, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, DANIS has requested the City's approval to use various subcontractors in accordance with Section 2.3.2.1 of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, DANIS has recommended the City approve bids from the subcontractors indicated in "Option 2" of the attached bid package summary; and

WHEREAS, DANIS has indicated the bidders indicated in "Option 2" were the lowest and best bidders and are qualified to perform the respective portions of the project; and

WHEREAS, DANIS has indicated that certain bid packages either received no bids, or all bids received were rejected; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Director of Public Works have indicated that certain and specific amounts were budgeted for each of the bid packages that

either received no bids, or all bids received were rejected, and said budgeted amounts have been indicated on the bid package summary attached hereto as Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, DANIS has provided under the terms of the Agreement that the guaranteed maximum price of the public works facility will not exceed Five Million, Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars, (\$5,800,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Director of Public Works recommend that the City approve the recommended subcontractors indicated in "Option 2" of Exhibit "A;" and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Director of Public Works recommend that all bid packages for which no bids were received, or for which all bids received were rejected, be rebid.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1: That the bidders stated in "Option 2" of the attached bid package summary are those recommended for use by DANIS, and that no other bidders are recommended.

Section 2: That the bidders stated in "Option 2" of the bid package summary attached hereto are hereby deemed acceptable for use under the Agreement entered into pursuant to Resolution 45-06.

Section 3. That all bid packages for which no bids were received, or for which all bids received were rejected, shall be rebid, and that DANIS is approved, subject to the concurrence of the City Manager, to use any subcontractor it recommends who submits a bid.

Section 4: That the Guaranteed Maximum Price for the Project shall not exceed Five Million, Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars, (\$5,800,000.00).

Section 5: That all other terms of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
