A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE COPS OFFICE FOR A COPS HIRING RECOVERY PROGRAM (CHRP) GRANT FOR THE SALARY AND FRINGE BENEFITS OF ONE ENTRY LEVEL POLICE OFFICER FOR A THREE YEAR PERIOD.

WHEREAS, the COPS Office has economic stimulus funding through the Justice Assistance Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville wishes to submit an application for \$220,864.00 for the salary and fringe benefits of one entry level police officer for a period of three years, and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville understands that the terms of the grant require the City to keep the officer for one year after the three years of funding.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application to the COPS Office for three years of funding for the salary and fringe benefits of one entry level police officer.
