A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR A GRANT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN JUSTICE FUNDING FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR THE DIGITAL UPGRADE OF POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice has streamlined justice funding and grant administration by establishing the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville wishes to submit an application to the 2009 Recovery Act: Justice Assistance Grant Program for \$368,300.00 for the digital upgrade of the Centerville Police Department's communications equipment, and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Justice Assistance Grant Program provide 75% of the required funds in the grant with the remaining 25% being provided by the City of Centerville.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign and submit an application to the 2009 Recovery Act: Justice Assistance Grant Program for funding of the above mentioned Police Department communications equipment.
