A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH RICHARD L. WIEGAND AND DOLORES L. WIEGAND TO ALLOW PROPERTY OWNERS TO CONTINUE TO LOCATE A FENCE IN THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS, the City holds a public right of way along the east boundary of the real property located at 1113 Green Tree Drive, Dayton, Ohio 45429; and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville has negotiated a License Agreement for the sole purpose of allowing the owners, Richard L. Wiegand and Dolores L. Wiegand, to erect and maintain a fence along the east boundary of the tract commonly known as 1113 Green Tree Drive, Dayton, Ohio 45429, upon terms acceptable to the City; and

WHEREAS, Council has the power to enter into such Lease Agreement by virtue of its Charter and the provisions of Article VIII, Section 16 and Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution;

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a License Agreement with Richard L. Wiegand and Dolores L. Wiegand, upon the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.

Section 2:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to do any and everything necessary to carry out the terms of said Agreement.

WITNESSETH:

For and in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The Licensor hereby licenses and authorizes the Licensee or its agents the right to enter upon and use certain City right-of-way which adjoins Licensee's east property boundary, as more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein for the sole purpose of erecting and maintaining a fence and for no other purpose.
- Licensee specifically agrees that it shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Licensor and its officials, officers and employees from any and all damages, injuries or losses suffered by any person arising as a result of the fence's presence and location, including visibility obstructions.
- 3. Licensor further grants to Licensee the right to repair and maintain said fence at the sole cost of the Licensee. Upon the revocation or termination of this Agreement, Licensee at its sole expense shall promptly remove the fence from the City property. Licensor reserves the right to inspect said property at any and all reasonable times.
- 4. This Agreement shall be for an indefinite period of time; provided however, that either party hereto shall have the right to revoke and terminate this Agreement and the license granted herein for any reason or no reason by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other party of its intention to do so.
- 5. LICENSEE ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE PROPERTY WHICH IS THE SUBJECT OF THE LICENSE GRANTED HEREIN IS HELD BY THE CITY AS PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY FOR PUBLIC TRAIL PURPOSES AND AS SUCH MAY BE USED FOR THAT PURPOSE

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AT ANY TIME. LICENSEE ACKNOWLEDGES AND ASSUMES THE FINANCIAL RISK INCIDENT TO ITS PLACING A FENCE IN SAID RIGHT OF WAY UNDER THESE CIRCUMSTANCES.

6. This Agreement is a license in real estate and the rights created by it are personal to those named herein and non-assignable. This Agreement does not pass any interest in the property described above.
