A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACTION OF THE

TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S
OFFICE FOR SALARY FUNDING OF A DARE OFFICER.

WHEREAS, a grant application is available through the Ohio Attorney
General's Office for salary funding of a DARE officer, and

WHEREAS, the Centerville Board of Education supports the application
for a grant by the Centerville Police Department to the Ohio Attorney General's office for
salary funding of a DARE officer; the Board values the DARE program and appreciates
the continuing efforts of the Centerville Police Department in educating the community's
youth about the dangers of drugs and alcohol, and

WHEREAS, the Centerville Police Department wishes to apply for said
grant to the Ohio Attorney General's office.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the actions of the City Manager, on behalf of the City of
Centerville, to make application to the Ohio Attorney General's office for salary funding
of a DARE officer for the City of Centerville Police Department is hereby ratified.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed
by law.
