A RESOLUTION ENACTED BY THE CITY OF
CENTERVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO,
REFERRED TO AS THE LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY
(LPA), IN THE MATTER OF THE STATED DESCRIBED
PROJECT.

SECTION I. **Project Description**

WHEREAS, the LPA has identified the need for the described project: This project proposes to plane and resurface the existing roadway and other roadway related items.

WHEREAS, said portion of described project is within the municipal corporation limits. PID No. 24680, MOT SR48 1.50.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

SECTION II. **Consent Statement**

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III. **Cooperation Statement**

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

ODOT will provide funding from its allocated Urban Paving funds on an 80/20 basis with the State providing the 80 percent of the funding for the project.

The LPA agrees to pay one hundred percent (100%) of the cost to install and/or repair curb ramps at all necessary intersections to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

And further, if the LPA requests to perform any other work beyond the resurfacing treatment, the LPA shall assume and bear 100% of the costs associated with those items.

SECTION IV. Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required (if applicable) for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodations, relocations and reimbursements will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 65 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V. Maintenance

Maintain the right-of-way and keep it free of obstructions, and hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VI. Authority to Sign

The City Manager of said City of Centerville is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of Centerville to enter into agreements with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.
