## RESOLUTION NO. 22-85 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Brooks A. Compton ON THE 20th DAY OF June, 2005.

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACTION TAKEN BY THE CITY MANAGER TO GRANT AN EASEMENT, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER AND WATER LINE THROUGH PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, it was necessary for the City of Centerville to grant unto the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County an easement for the construction of a sanitary sewer line and a water line to provide service to properties in the Yankee Trace Development, and

WHEREAS, to accomplish this the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, Ohio, requested a 20 foot easement taken evenly off the following described centerline: beginning at the northeast corner of Section 4, Town 2 Range 5 M.Rs. and the northwest corner of Section 34; thence, with said Section line, South 02° 48'24" West, 461.71 feet to the southerly line of the Woodlands at Yankee Trace Subdivision, Section One; thence, with the said Woodlands at Yankee Trace Subdivision, Section One, North 75°18'03" West, 403.38 feet, to the true point of beginning; thence, departing said Woodlands at Yankee Trace Subdivision Section One, South 87°52'26" West, 10.18 Feet; thence, South 08°33'37" West, 128.69 feet; thence, South 18°36'13" West, 33.60 feet to its terminus at an existing water main easement.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the action taken by the City Manager be and is hereby ratified to do all things necessary in executing the grant of an easement to the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County, Ohio, to construct a sanitary sewer line and a water line through property owned by the City of Centerville to provide service to properties located in Yankee Trace, said easement further described in Exhibit "A", a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.


