

RESOLUTION NO. 49-05

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Paul Shusham ON THE 19th DAY
OF September, 2005.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MUNICIPAL ATTORNEY TO FILE ACTIONS FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF AGAINST ANY SEXUAL OFFENDER RESIDING WITHIN THE CITY AND WITHIN 1000 FEET OF ANY SCHOOL AS DEFINED BY §2950.01(R) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, the §2950.031(B) authorizes any city law director to apply to any court of competent jurisdiction for injunctive relief to cause the removal of any sexual offender as defined by §2950.01, Ohio Revised Code and who resides within 1000 feet from any school within the city as defined by §2950.01(R), Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined that it would be in the best interests of the citizens of Centerville to extend such authority to and direct the Municipal Attorney to take such action against any such individual when he is made aware of that person's residence.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Municipal Attorney is authorized and directed to take any and every action authorized by §2950.031(B), Ohio Revised Code.
