A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MULTI-USE TRAIL
PLAN FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND
WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville strives to preserve and enhance the unique high quality of life, community character and fiscal well-being offered to those who live or work in this community, and

WHEREAS, In 2004, a Multi-Use Trail Task Force was formed to develop a plan for a safe and user-friendly multi-use trail system that fosters community connectivity while promoting alternative modes of transportation and enhancing the physical fitness and quality of life for local citizens, and

WHEREAS, The plan has been reviewed and refined by the City of Centerville, Washington Township, the Centerville-Washington Park District and the Create the Vision Implementation Task Force.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Multi-Use Trail Plan developed and recommended by the Task Force be and is hereby adopted.
