

RESOLUTION NO. 1-04
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Douglas C. Cline ON THE 26th DAY OF January, 2004.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AS SUBMITTED BY THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE THE REVISED DIRECTIVES GOVERNING THE COMBINED AGENCIES FOR NARCOTIC ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE (CANE); PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT ANY PROVISION RELATING TO INDEMNIFICATION SHALL BE BINDING UPON THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO ONLY TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Prosecutor has indicated his desire for approval of the revised CANE Drug Task Force Directives for the day-to-day running of the task force on behalf of the Combined Agencies for Narcotics Enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager is authorized to accept the revised directives governing the CANE Task Force on the condition that any provision therein relating to any requirement for indemnification shall have binding effect upon the City of Centerville, Ohio only to the extent permitted by law.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council certify a copy of this resolution to the Montgomery County Prosecutor's Office.
