A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO ACCEPT A REIMBURSABLE GRANT, AND
IMPLEMENT AN INTERSECTION SAFETY STUDY OF
SOUTH MAIN STREET (STATE ROUTE 48) AND
SPRING VALLEY ROAD.

WHEREAS, It is important to review the operation of State Route 48 and Spring
Valley Road to search for improvements in safety and traffic congestion
relief, and

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville has received a reimbursable grant from the
Ohio Department of Safety/Governor's Highway Safety Office for the
study of long term and short term solutions for improvements in safety and
traffic congestion relief at State Route 48 and Spring Valley Road.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept a \$5,000.00
reimbursable grant, make expenditures, and implement an
intersection safety study of South Main Street (State Route 48) and
Spring Valley Road.


