A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACTION TAKEN BY THE CITY MANAGER TO PARTICIPATE IN A CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OFFICE OF STATE PURCHASING FOR THE PURCHASE OF FURNITURE FOR THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING RENOVATION PROJECT IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-88.

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 19-88, passed by the Council of the City of Centerville, Ohio, on the 16th day of January, 1989, authorized the City of Centerville to participate in contracts with the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing for the purpose of purchasing supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into a contract with Elements IV Interiors in Dayton, Ohio, for the purchase of furniture in accordance with Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the action taken by the City Manager be and is hereby ratified to participate in a contract between the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, and Elements IV Interiors, for the purchase of furniture for the Municipal Building Renovation Project, for the total price of \$80,982.14.

Section 2. That the City of Centerville directly pay the vendor for said furniture, under state contract.
