A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY THE JOHN R. JURGENSEN COMPANY, FOR THE 2004 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, CONCRETE REPAIR AND ASPHALT RESURFACING IN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville advertised for bidders for the 2004 Road Improvement Project, Concrete Repair and Asphalt Resurfacing in the City of Centerville according to specifications prepared by the City, and

WHEREAS, the John R. Jurgensen Company was the low and best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by the John R. Jurgensen Company for the 2004 Road Improvement Project, Concrete Repair and Asphalt Resurfacing, marked as exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof be and is hereby accepted in the amount of \$594,559.32 and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into any necessary contract to evidence acceptance of said bid and to make payment pursuant thereto.

Section 2. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized to expend up to a total amount of \$620,000.00 in accordance with unit prices quoted in the bid submitted by the John R. Jurgensen Company in order to allow for contingencies during the reconstruction project.
