A RESOLUTION DECLARING SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT
NO LONGER UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF

SAID SURPLUS PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH

WHEREAS, equipment no longer needed for use by City personnel may be
declared as surplus property.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the property outlined in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a
part hereof is hereby declared as surplus property, and the City Manager is hereby
authorized and directed to offer said property for public auction, in accordance with
Section 721.15, Ohio Revised Code.


