A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACTION TAKEN BY
THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION
TO THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS FOR A COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT TO PROVIDE
HANDICAP ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS IN
STUBBS PARK.

WHEREAS, The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners is accepting applications for Fiscal Years 2003, 2004, and 2005 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) projects, and

WHEREAS, It was the intent of the City of Centerville to apply for a (CDBG) grant to provide for handicap accessibility improvements in Stubbs Park.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the action taken by the City Manager be and is hereby ratified to submit an application to the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners for a Community Development Block (CDBG) grant to provide for handicap accessibility improvements in Stubbs Park, a copy of which is attached hereto, marked as exhibit "A".

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby directed to enter into subsequent contracts, all understanding and assurances contained therein, to act in connection with the submission of the application and subsequent contracts, and to provide such additional information as may be required.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.

II. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Stubbs Park Bridge Accessibility Improvements will provide for replacement of 6 bridges along the recently paved pathways within Stubbs Park. This project is a continuation of the 2003 CDBG project that provided for the asphalt paving of approximately 2000 lineal feet of pathway in the Park to provide improved access for physically challenged park users. These improvements intend to correct deficiencies that exist regarding accessibility for physically challenged park users. It's the next step in a continuing effort to make this select area within Stubbs Park compliant with the American Disabilities Act (ADA).

Impact/Benefit (How many persons/households served? How many linear feet? Etc.)

The project will include replacement of 6 pedestrian bridges.

The Improvements will enhance facilities in the Park that were previously inaccessible to physically challenged park users. The project is estimated to benefit the approximately 3500 of Centerville's 23,024 residents who are physically challenged. Additionally physically challenged individuals who do not live in the area, but use the Park will also benefit. This project meets criteria benefiting low and moderate income persons.

III. PROJECT GOALS:

The project goal includes providing safe and equal access for all park users within the area of Stubbs Park targeted for accessibility improvements.

\$85,000 will be spent on improvements in FY 2003 consistent with the above goal.

Projects such as this are not easily able to be evaluated quantitatively. Most likely the best way to evaluate this project will be to observe park users and the ease with which physically challenged users use the improved facilities.

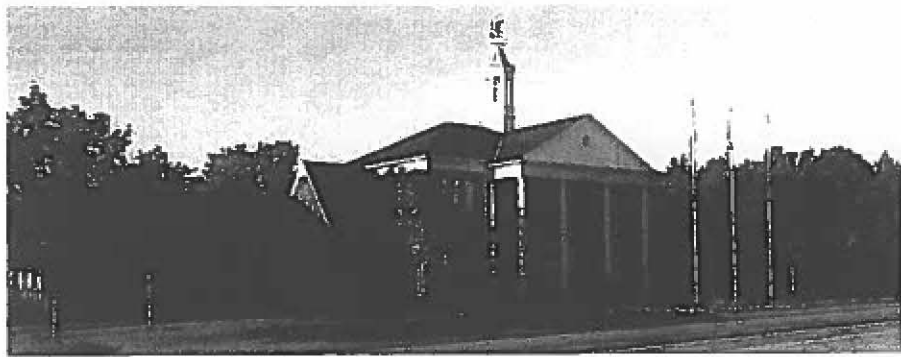

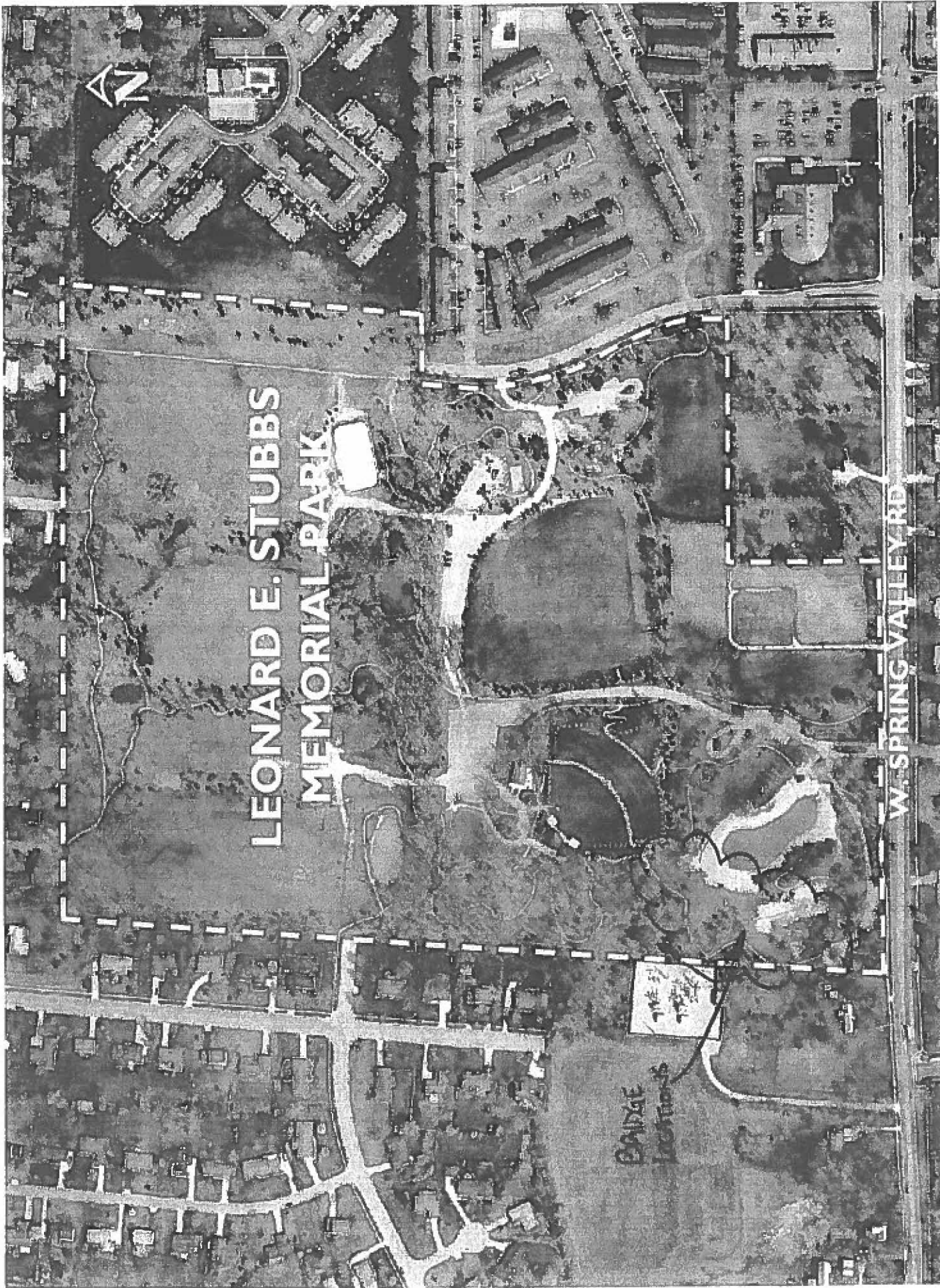

MEMORIAL PARK

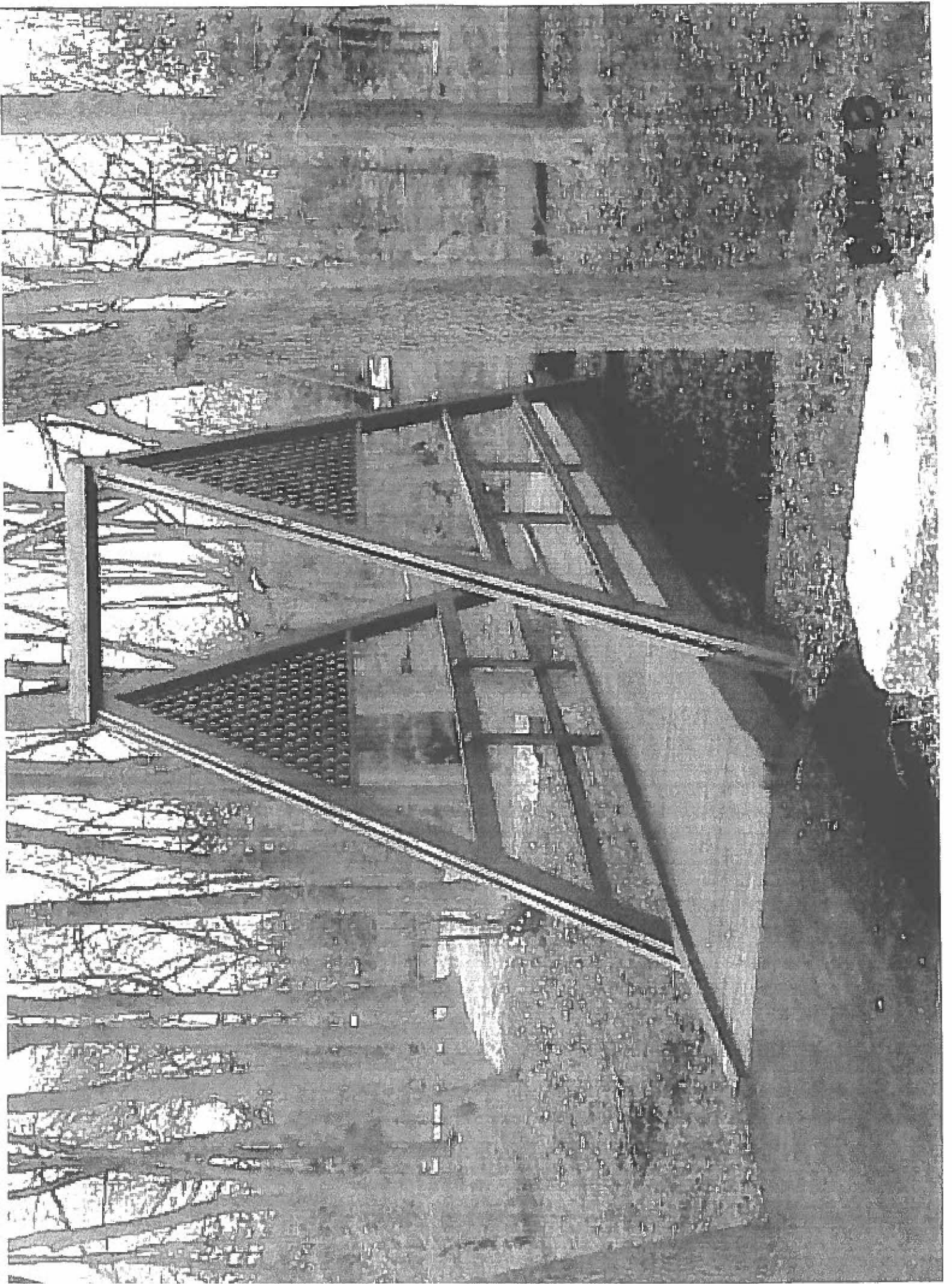

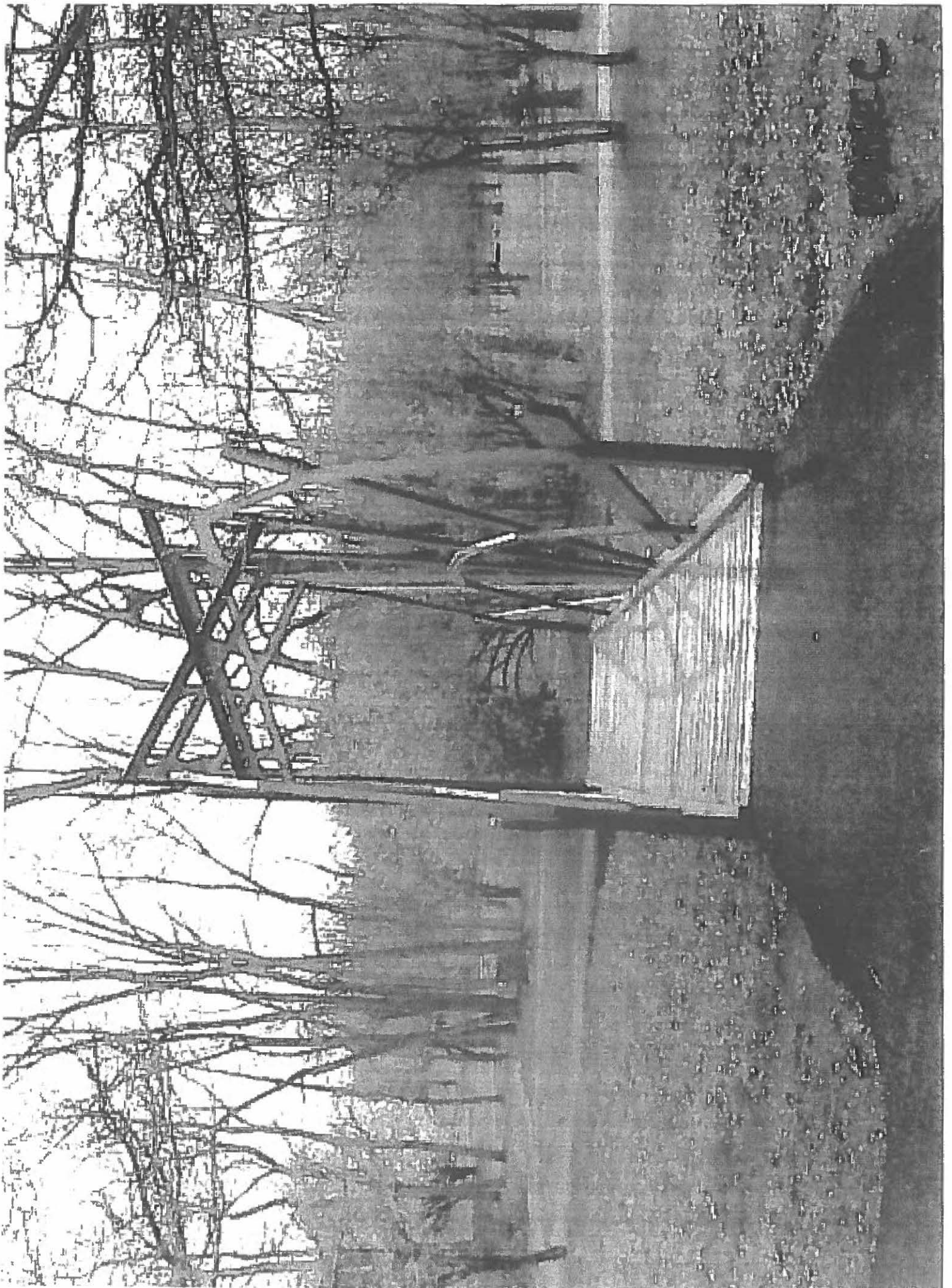
