II. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Stubbs Park Bridge Accessibility Improvements will provide for replacement of 6 bridges along the recently paved pathways within Stubbs Park. This project is a continuation of the 2003 CDBG project that provided for the asphalt paving of approximately 2000 lineal feet of pathway in the Park to provide improved access for physically challenged park users. These improvements intend to correct deficiencies that exist regarding accessibility for physically challenged park users. It's the next step in a continuing effort to make this select area within Stubbs Park compliant with the American Disabilities Act (ADA).

Impact/Benefit (How many persons/households served? How many linear feet? Etc.)

The project will include replacement of 6 pedestrian bridges.

The Improvements will enhance facilities in the Park that were previously inaccessible to physically challenged park users. The project is estimated to benefit the approximately 3500 of Centerville's 23,024 residents who are physically challenged. Additionally physically challenged individuals who do not live in the area, but use the Park will also benefit. This project meets criteria benefiting low and moderate income persons.
