A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PARTICIPATE IN A CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, OFFICE OF STATE PURCHASING FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO DUMP TRUCKS FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-88.

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 19-88, passed by the Council of the City of Centerville, Ohio, on the 16th day of January, 1989, authorized the City of Centerville to participate in contracts of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing for the purpose of purchasing supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into a contract with 32 Ford in Batavia, Ohio, for the purchase of certain equipment, in accordance with Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager be authorized to participate in a contract between the Department of Administrative Services Office of State Purchasing and 32 Ford for the purchase of two dump trucks (cab and chassis), and a Shop repair Manual for a total bid price of \$50,545.45.

Section 2. That the City of Centerville directly pay the vendor for said vehicles, under state contract.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
