## RESOLUTION NO. 29-03 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER <u>Susan W. Limesch</u> ON THE <u>2/s+</u> DAY OF <u>July</u>, 2003.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE'S APPLICATION FOR STATE ISSUE TWO FUNDS (SI2P) OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT FUNDS (LTIP) FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION AND WIDENING OF CENTERVILLE STATION ROAD FROM PARKEAST COURT EAST TO A LOCATION WEST OF THE CORPORATION LIMITS (APPROXIMATELY 0.40 MILES).

WHEREAS, voters of Ohio passed Issue 2 authorizing the State of Ohio to issue bonds for the purpose of financing or assisting local governments in financing Public Infrastructure Capital Improvements, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Centerville to apply for State Issue 2 Funds or Local Transportation Improvement Funds for Public Infrastructure Capital Improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit applications with appropriate signatures for Capital Improvement Projects as defined in Section 164.01(A) of the Ohio Revised Code and H.B. 704 and to provide such information as may be requested by the District 4 Public Works Integrating Committee, or by the State Commission Director or Administrators.

Section 2. The City of Centerville hereby commits the local share of the grant and any costs exceeding the estimate for the reconstruction and widening of Centerville Station Road from Parkeast Court east to a location west of the Corporation Limits (approximately 0.40 miles) in the City of Centerville utilizing S12P or LTIP funds.

Section 3. The City of Centerville will voluntarily contribute to the District 4 Public Works Integrating Committee, up to one percent (1%) of funded project estimates, loans or credit enhancements. <u>Section 4.</u> The City of Centerville recognizes that project cost overruns may not be funded by the District 4 Committee.

<u>Section 5.</u> The City of Centerville commits to the reporting requirements contained in Section III of the Standing Rules of the District 4 Committee.

Section 6. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
