**RESOLUTION OF NON-SUPPORT FOR THE TREATMENT OF
HYDROLYSATE AT THE PERMA-FIX FACILITY IN JEFFERSON
TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO.**

WHEREAS, Centerville City Council is concerned about the quality of the environment and the safety and health of the Centerville area residents as well as residents of our surrounding communities, and

WHEREAS, the United States Army has preliminary plans to treat hydrolysate, a byproduct of VX Nerve Gas, at the Perma-Fix plant in Jefferson Township, and

WHEREAS, the potential hazards of the transportation, storage and treatment are unknown at this point, and

WHEREAS, Montgomery County Commissioners have contracted for an independent/professional review of this issue, and


WHEREAS, the review is expected to be complete in the next few weeks.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Centerville City Council does not support the treatment of hydrolysate at Perma-Fix in Jefferson Township, Montgomery County until such time as the United States Army is able to effectively demonstrate that the treatment process and transportation of hydrolysate is safe for all area residents.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
