A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MONTGOMERY ALL NATURAL
HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville recognizes the vulnerability of its resources,
property and operations to the impacts of disasters and emergencies, and

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville also recognizes its role in the community and
its importance to the welfare of the people and institutions therein, and

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville endorses the objectives of The Montgomery
County Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, and acknowledges that it can support the Plan in
the achievement of those goals in appropriate ways.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City of Centerville commits to undertake the following
action:

To participate in its efforts to the extent feasible and in a manner consistent with
the City of Centerville needs, resources and responsibilities to lessen the vulnerability of
the community to the impacts of disasters, as established in The Montgomery County
Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force
immediately upon passage.
