A RESOLUTION DECLARING SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT NO LONGER UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF SAID SURPLUS PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES AS STATED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville desires to maintain adequate equipment to be utilized at Yankee Trace, and

WHEREAS, equipment no longer needed for use at Yankee Trace may be declared as surplus property.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That a Vulcan Steamer (VSX5 208 Volt) no longer of use in the Gallery at Yankee Trace be and is hereby declared as surplus property, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to offer said property for sale in accordance with Chapter 212 of the Centerville Municipal Code.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.


