A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE CITY OF
CENTERVILLE'S APPLICATION TO THE OHIO
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, GOVERNOR'S
HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE, FOR A 402 GRANT TO
DEVELOP A HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAM
FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE.

WHEREAS, By application to the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Governor's
Highway Safety Office, funding is available for the development of a
Highway Safety Program, and

WHEREAS, It is the intent of the City of Centerville to apply for a 402 Grant in
order to proactively repair signs and effectively budget for sign
replacements on a continuing basis, allowing Centerville to identify
and track needs both to eliminate any backlog and keep pace in the
future.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit
an application with appropriate signatures to the Ohio Department of
Public Safety, Governor's Highway Safety Office, for a 402 Grant for the
development of a Highway Safety Program for the City of Centerville.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
