

RESOLUTION NO. 56-02
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Douglas C. Cline ON THE
16th DAY OF December, 2002.

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID FROM THE
MORTON SALT COMPANY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE
MORTON SALT COMPANY FOR THE PURCHASE OF
HIGHWAY ROCK SALT FOR SNOW AND ICE CONTROL
FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE FOR THE YEAR 2003.

WHEREAS, the Southwest Ohio Purchaser's for Government (SWOP4G) advertised for
bidders for Highway Rock Salt pursuant to specifications prepared by SWOP4G; and

WHEREAS, the Morton Salt Company was the low and best bidder for the City of
Centerville, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY
RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by the Morton Salt Company for the purchase of
highway rock salt submitted to Southwest Ohio Purchaser's for Government, be and is hereby
accepted for the purchase price of \$32.54 per ton, plus \$1.50 per ton piling charge, the total cost
of which is (\$32.54 + \$1.50 times 1,800 tons) \$61,272.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into any
necessary agreement to evidence acceptance of said bid and to make payment pursuant thereto.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
