A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO APPROPRIATE
CERTAIN INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTY AND
EASEMENTS FOR THE MOT-725-20.10 EAST
ALEXANDERSVILLE-BELLBROOK ROAD
RECONSTRUCTION AND WIDENING PROJECT
FROM MELVIN D. AND PRISCILLA E. SNYDER,
PARCEL NO. 19-WD.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville is engaged in the acquisition of right of way and temporary construction easements for the MOT-725-20.10 East Alexandersville-Bellbrook Road Reconstruction and Widening Project within the corporate limits of Centerville, and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of that parcel of real estate is immediately necessary for the roadway construction in connection with said project, and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the lands hereinafter described are necessary for roadway construction in connection with such project so that there will be no delay for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby declares the necessity and intention to appropriate certain real property in accordance with Chapter 163 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 2. It is necessary and intention to appropriate certain roadway right of way and easements in the real estate described herein: as more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached and incorporated herein.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager or his designate is hereby authorized to cause written notice of the adoption of this Resolution to be given to the owners, persons in possession of, or having an interest of record in the above described premises, and said notice shall be served according to law by a person to be designated for that purpose by said City Manager or his designate and to make return of said service of notice in the manner provided by law.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

Dollars (\$ _____) to him paid by the City of Centerville _____, the Grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said

Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

Situated in the City of Centerville _____, County of Montgomery _____, State of Ohio, and in Section 19 _____, Town 2 _____, Range 6 M.R.S. Washington Township _____, and bounded and described as follows:

PARCEL NO. 19.WD _____

Being a part of a 1.057 acre parcel acquired by Melvin and Priscilla Snyder as recorded in M. F. #95-328 C01 and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a 5/8" iron pin in a monument box at the northeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 19, in the centerline intersection of Alex-Bell Road (S.R. 725) and Bigger Road at P.I. Station 1117+38.25;

Thence, with the centerline of Alex-Bell Road (S.R. 725), North 86° 22' 38" West, 678.70 feet to a mag nail set in the northeast corner of the Grantor's tract and the northwest corner of a parcel acquired by C. Phillips, M.F. #00-086 D07 at Station 1110+59.55 said point being the True Place of Beginning of the land herein described;

Thence, with the Grantor's east line and the west line of said C. Phillips, South 05° 18' 22" West, 60.03 feet to an iron pin set in the new right-of-way line, 60.00 feet right of Station 1110+57.79;

Thence, with the new right-of-way line, North 89° 38' 34" West, 150.77 feet to an iron pin set in the Grantor's west line and the east line of a parcel acquired by V. M. Asta, M.F. #96-310 A01, 65.00 feet right of Station 1108+86.53;

Thence, with the Grantor's west line and the east line of said V.M. Asta, North 05° 26' 47" East, 68.62 feet to a mag nail set at the Grantor's northwest corner in the centerline of Alex-Bell Road, Station 1109+09.45;

Thence, with the centerline of said road, South 86° 22' 38" East, 150.10 feet to the True Place of Beginning.

All iron pins set are capped 5/8"x30" with "WORL & ASSOC." stamped on cap.

It is understood the above contains a total of 0.222 of an acre, more or less, including the present road which occupies 0.114 of an acre, more or less.

Of the above described area, 0.222 of an acre is to be deleted from Auditor's Tax Duplicate Number 068-006-07-0014.

The description for parcel number 19.WD above was calculated and derived from a centerline survey of Alex-Bell Rd. (S.R. 725) made by Worl and Associates, Inc. for the City of Centerville _____, under the direction and supervision of Mark B. Studebaker, Registered Surveyor Number 7074. Stations referenced above have been established on the existing centerline of right-of-way of Alex-Bell Road, (State Route 725), the centerline Plat of MOT-725-20.10 is recorded in Plat Book 179 Page 26 of the Montgomery County Plat Records. Bearings used within are based on the centerline of Bigger Road and the east line of Section 20, being North 04° 47' 15" East as shown on Plat Book 159, Page 32A.

Said stations being the Station numbers as stipulated in the hereinbefore mentioned survey and as shown by plans on file in the Department of Transportation, Columbus, Ohio.
