DAY OF June, 2001.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF A  
PROCUREMENT METHODOLOGY FOR EVALUATING AND  
SECURING A TECHNOLOGY PACKAGE FOR THE CITY'S NEW  
POLICE FACILITY AND WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

WHEREAS, the City is presently constructing a new facility fir the Centerville  
Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the said new facility will require the installation of state of the art  
technology which is subject to the fast pace of design innovation and evolution; and

WHEREAS, City police personnel and representatives of Heapy Engineering  
have been working together to develop a performance specification for the technology  
package for the said new facility; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed that procurement of the technology system be based  
on direct evaluation and negotiation with preselected qualified providers based upon  
previous experience as may be known to Heapy Engineering; and

WHEREAS, this council further finds that competitive bidding would be a useless  
act and would not benefit the City and its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE,


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager and his designees are hereby  
authorized and directed to work with Heapy Engineering to develop a performance  
specification and to procure the services of the best qualified provider all as described in  
the preamble hereof and to execute all contracts and other documents necessary to carry  
out the provisions of this resolution. Competitive bidding is hereby waived for the  
foregoing reasons.


