A RESOLUTION DECLARING SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT NO LONGER UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF SAID SURPLUS PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES AS STATED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville presently owns computer equipment which is no longer of use in the Centerville Police Department, and

WHEREAS, The Franciscan at St. Leonard has a need for computer equipment for placement in a lab for the purpose of training residents a variety of tasks on the use of computers and accessing the Internet, and

WHEREAS, It appears in the best interest of the City to declare computer equipment as surplus property no longer of use to the City to benefit the residents at The Franciscan at St. Leonard, and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Section 212.035 of the Centerville Municipal Code, the City Manager with the consent of City Council may adopt alternative procedures for the disposal of surplus property.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the following property be and is hereby declared as surplus property, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of said property in accordance with Section 212.035:
