A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE ACTION OF THE CITY MANAGER IN EXECUTING A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$71,000.00 FOR TRAINING ROOM AV SYSTEMS WITH DELTA INNOVATIONS LTD. AND WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that its normal competitive bidding procedure is not practical in this case because the type of training room AV systems the City has determined must be used can only be supplied by Delta Innovations Ltd; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager in prior consultation with the Council at an open meeting work session called pursuant to §121.22, Ohio Revised Code discussed the purchase of said training room AV systems and was instructed by the Council to execute a contract with said Delta Innovations Ltd.; and

WHEREAS, said decision and instruction are consistent with the methodology adopted by this Council by Resolution 52-01 adopted June 18, 2001; and

WHEREAS, this City has full Home Rule powers as set forth in its Charter and in §3, Article XVIII of the Constitution of Ohio and hereby invokes same in the passage of this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the City Manager's action in executing a contract with Delta Innovations Ltd in the amount of \$71,000.00 for training room AV systems purchase and hereby waives competitive bidding for the reason stated above.
