A RESOLUTION DECLARING A FORFEITED VEHICLE
AWARDED TO THE CENTERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT
BY THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COMMON PLEAS COURT
AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF SAID SURPLUS PROPERTY IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES AS STATED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, The Montgomery County Common Pleas Court awarded a forfeited

ready for police service, and

RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the vehicle described below is declared as surplus property, and
the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to offer said property for public
auction, in accordance with Section 721.15, Ohio Revised Code.
