A RESOLUTION DECLARING SPECIFIC EQUIPMENT NO LONGER UTILIZED BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF SAID SURPLUS PROPERTY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GUIDELINES AS STATED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, With the installation of the core financial modules on the City of Centerville's new computer system, the old IBM System 36 is no longer needed, and

WHEREAS, It appears in the best interest of the City to render the hard drive and the rest of the system and components useless and to declare said equipment as surplus property, and

WHEREAS, In accordance with Section 212.035 of the Centerville Municipal Code, the City Manager with the consent of City Council may adopt alternative procedures for the disposal of surplus property having an estimated value of more than one thousand dollars (1,000.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the following property be and is hereby declared as surplus property, and the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of said property in accordance with Section 212.035:
