The City will assist with the lay-out and provide approval of all sidewalk, curb ramp, etc. lay-out prior to any concrete being placed. There may be adjustments to the planned sidewalk location based on individual property owner input, however final direction on location will be determined by the City.

- 2. Individual property owners have been given the opportunity to remove landscape features ahead of the project. Therefore several of the Item 202 Removals may be non-performed.
- 3. Restoration shall include all grading, placement of topsoil, and seeding and mulching of all disturbed areas. Please reference detail for grading requirements.

4. Montgomery County has indicated that one coupling per water service would be permitted should a water meter need to be relocated. Therefore the price bid should reflect relocating the existing water meter and meter pit (and possibly replacing the same) and replacing the appropriate length of pipe. The Contractor is responsible to make all necessary arrangements for permits, inspections, etc. with Montgomery County.
