RESOLUTION NO. 27-00 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Roger Knows ON THE 2/st DAY OF August, 2000.

A RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE NEW POLICE HEADQUARTERS FACILITY AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO CAUSE THE PROJECT TO BE REBID.

WHEREAS, this council has determined that the City is in need of a new police headquarters facility in order to adequately serve the present and future needs of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, this council previously authorized the securing of competitive bids through the City's established bidding process; and

WHEREAS, the bidding process produced three bids all of which were in excess of the engineer's estimate for the project by more than twenty percent (20%); and

WHEREAS, this City as a charter city with full home rule powers as authorized by Section 3, Article XVIII of the Constitution of the State of Ohio which powers would allow the City to waive the requirements that acceptable bids be within ten percent (10%) of the engineer's estimate but that this council determines that such a procedure is not in the best interests of the citizens of Centerville; and

WHEREAS, this council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to make revisions to the plans and specifications for the proposed for the police headquarters in order to reduce costs and to cause the entire process to be rebid; and

WHEREAS, this council by adopting this resolution is in no way waiving its rights under Section 3, Article XVIII of the Constitution of the State of Ohio; §§301 and 303 of the Centerville Charter and prior judicial determinations of the home rule power in public contracting to adopt a different procedure in awarding a public contract for the construction of the said police headquarters facility, including, but not limited to a negotiated contract process;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. That all of the bids previously submitted for the construction of the said police headquarters facility are hereby rejected.

Section 2. That, in accordance with Chapter 210 of the Centerville Municipal Code the City Manager is authorized and directed to cause the entire process to be rebid.
