

RESOLUTION NO. 38-00  
CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Douglas C. Cline ON THE 16<sup>th</sup>  
DAY OF October, 2000.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THAT A CONTRIBUTION OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT AND SIXTY-SEVEN HUNDREDTHS DOLLARS (\$186,628.67) BE MADE BY THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO TO THE CENTERVILLE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT CORPORATION TO BE USED FOR PROMOTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Centerville Community Improvement Corporation (hereinafter "the CIC") was incorporated as an Ohio nonprofit corporation pursuant to Chapter 1724, Ohio Revised Code "for the sole purpose of advancing, encouraging, and promoting the industrial, economic, commercial, and civic development" within the City of Centerville, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, in order for the CIC to better carry out its statutory purpose, the Council of the City of Centerville has determined to make a contribution to the CIC in the amount of ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT AND SIXTY-SEVEN HUNDREDTHS DOLLARS (\$186,628.67); and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General of Ohio in Opinion 91-071 has ruled that: "[p]ursuant to Ohio Const. art. XVIII, § 3, and in light of R.C. 307.78 and R.C. 505.701, a municipal corporation has authority to make contributions of public money to a community improvement corporation organized pursuant to R.C. Chapter 1724, in order to defray expenses of the community improvement corporation incurred in connection with its functions under R.C. Chapter 1724"; and

WHEREAS, the CIC in pursuance of its charge by this Council that it advance, encourage and promote the industrial, economic, commercial, and civic development within the City proposes to jointly purchase certain real property with Yankee Trace Development, Inc. to be used in connection with a proposed expansion of the City's golf facilities; and


WHEREAS, this Council hereby finds that said proposal would promote a valid municipal purpose for which public funds may be expended;

NOW THEREFORE,


THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager and Director of Finance are hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary in order to carry out the purposes of this Resolution and to cause a contribution of ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT AND SIXTY-SEVEN HUNDREDTHS DOLLARS (\$186,628.67) to be made to the CIC for the purpose stated in the preamble of this Resolution.


