A RESOLUTION WAIVING REIMBURSEMENT FROM  
THE CITY OF XENIA FOR SERVICES RENDERED BY  
THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE DURING THE  
SEPTEMBER 20, 2000 TORNADO.

WHEREAS, The City of Centerville assisted the City of Xenia with manpower and equipment during the September 20, 2000 tornado in their City, and

WHEREAS, The City of Xenia has offered reimbursement for these services to the City of Centerville based upon the Federal Emergency Management Agency's rate schedule, and

WHEREAS, At this particular time, the City of Centerville wishes to waive any reimbursement costs for services rendered by the City of Centerville during the September 20, 2000 tornado.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City of Centerville hereby waives any reimbursement offered by and paid for by the City of Xenia for manpower and equipment utilized during the disaster that occurred in the City of Xenia on September 20, 2000.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council for the City of Centerville is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to James Percival, City Manager, City of Xenia, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Resolution become effective immediately upon passage.
