A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUPPORT A COUNTYWIDE REGIONAL RETENTION AND EXPANSION INITIATIVE PROJECT ED/GE GRANT AND TO COMMIT FINANCIAL SUPPORT TOWARDS A PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF 2001-2005 PROJECT MAINTENANCE COSTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton, on behalf of municipalities and townships in the Greater Dayton area is submitting an ED/GE application to purchase, install, and provide training related to business retention and expansion software for use by all participating municipalities and townships; and,

WHEREAS, while the 2000-2001 costs would be included in the ED/GE grant, maintenance costs in 2001-2005, as well as potential hardware costs specific to each municipality, cannot be included therein; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville's proportionate share of project maintenance costs cannot exceed \$2,000.00 per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to support a countywide regional retention and expansion initiative, ED/GE grant and to commit financial support towards a proportionate share of the 2001-2005 maintenance costs: not to exceed \$2,000.00 upon proper fund authorization and appropriation.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
