SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Paul M. Shesham ON THE
20th DAY OF November, 2000.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE AND GENE BATES GOLF DESIGN, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL DESIGN SERVICES NECESSARY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIX NEW GOLF HOLES, AND MODIFICATION OF THE CITY'S EXISTING THREE HOLE PRACTICE FACILITY AT THE GOLF CLUB AT YANKEE TRACE.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville intends to construct and build six new golf holes, and modify the City's existing three-hole practice facility at The Golf Club at Yankee Trace, and

WHEREAS, The City desires to engage the services of Gene Bates Golf Design, Inc. to provide golf course design services in connection with the golf course addition as heretofore set forth, and

WHEREAS, Gene Bates Golf Design, Inc. representatives have visited the golf course addition site and agree to provide said services.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement between the City of Centerville and Gene Bates Golf Design, Inc. for design services for the construction of six new golf holes, and modify the City's existing three hole practice facility at The Golf Club at Yankee Trace at a cost not to exceed \$100,000 plus reimbursement expenses.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
