A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY  
THE L.P. CAVETT COMPANY FOR THE 1999 CONCRETE  
REPAIR AND ASPHALT RESURFACING ROAD  
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FOR THE CITY OF  
CENTERVILLE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER  
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT IN CONNECTION  
THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville advertised for bidders for the 1999 Concrete Repair and Asphalt Resurfacing Road Improvement Project, pursuant to the specifications prepared by the City; and

WHEREAS, the L.P. Cavett Company was the low and best bidder.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY  
RESOLVES:


Section 1. That the bid submitted by the L.P. Cavett Company for the 1999 Concrete Repair and Asphalt Resurfacing Road Improvement Project for a total cost of \$686,815.53, which includes \$16,480.52 for the Stress Reducing Membrane Interlayer for Marshall Road, is hereby accepted, a copy of said bid marked Exhibit "A" is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Centerville hereby authorizes the expenditure of the entire 1999 Road Improvement Project budget of \$750,000.00 to allow for the Normandy Lane work as well as contingency and recommended additional items.

Section 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into any necessary contract to evidence acceptance of said bid and to make payment pursuant thereto.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
