A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID FROM MORTON INTERNATIONAL, INC., MORTON SALT DIVISION, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MORTON INTERNATIONAL, INC., FOR THE PURCHASE OF HIGHWAY ROCK SALT FOR SNOW AND ICE CONTROL FOR 1999/2000 FOR THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Southwest Ohio Purchaser's for Government (SWOP4G) advertised for bidders for Highway Rock Salt pursuant to specifications prepared by SWOP4G; and

WHEREAS, SWOP4G received bids from Central Salt LLC, IMC Salt Inc., Cargill Inc., and Morton International Inc., for the purchase of highway rock salt; and

WHEREAS, Morton International, Inc., Morton Salt Division, is the low and best bidder for the City of Centerville, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by Morton International, Inc., Morton Salt Division, for the purchase of highway rock salt submitted to Southwest Ohio Purchaser's for Government, is hereby accepted for the purchase price of \$27.00 per ton, plus \$1.50 per ton piling charge, the total cost of which is (1,800 tons at \$28.50 per ton) \$51,300.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into any necessary agreement to evidence acceptance of said bid and to make payment pursuant thereto.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
