WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 19-88, passed by the Council of the City of Centerville, Ohio, on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1989, authorized the City of Centerville to participate in contracts of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing for the purpose of purchasing supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; and



Section 1. That the City Manager be authorized to purchase five 1998 Crown Victoria Patrol Cars from Stengers Ford as per specifications prepared by the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
