A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF DAYBREAK IN ITS EFFORTS TO IMPLEMENT THE SAFE PLACE PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO.
WHEREAS, Daybreak provides safety, comfort and guidance in Dayton, Ohio for runaway, homeless, and neglected youth in their formative years; and
WHEREAS, Daybreak has clearly defined its challenge and expanded its scope of service which began as safe shelter and evolved to empowering young people to take charge of their lives, approach their responsibilities with renewed perspective and vigor, and seek mature, realistic goals and objectives; and
WHEREAS, Daybreak is implementing the National Safe Place program to expand their outreach and prevention efforts to teens living in the suburban areas of Dayton; and
WHEREAS, The Safe Place program creates a network of "Safe Places" businesses and public locations that display the Safe Place sign; and
WHEREAS, Any young person in trouble may enter a Safe Place site to request help and employees at each site will work with area volunteers and Daybreak to see that the youth is safely transported to the Daybreak shelter; and
WHEREAS, Youth can seek help at a site in their own neighborhood and have easy, convenient access to Daybreak and its programs and services.
NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:
Section 1. That the Council of the City of Centerville hereby supports Daybreak in its efforts to implement The Safe Place program in the City of Centerville.
Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
