A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND RATIFYING THE
AMENDED MONTGOMERY COUNTY SOLID WASTE
MANAGEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville is a member of the Montgomery County Solid Waste District; and

WHEREAS, the Montgomery County Solid Waste District is required by law to submit an updated Solid Waste Management Plan to the Ohio EPA every three years; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Policy Committee adopted an Amended Solid Waste Management Plan on April 29, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the following adoption of the amended plan, the Solid Waste Management District is required to submit the plan update for ratification to each political jurisdiction in Montgomery County; and

WHEREAS, the amended Solid Waste Management Plan has been reviewed; and

WHEREAS, approval and ratification of the Amended Solid Waste Management Plan is recommended and warranted; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Amended Solid Waste Management Plan be approved.

Section 2. A copy of this resolution be mailed to the Solid Waste Management Policy Committee, attention Linda D. Williams, Montgomery County Public Works Department, 451 West Third Street, Dayton, Ohio 45422.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective at the earliest date allowed by law.
