

**RESOLUTION NO. 38-98**  
**CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO**

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER J. V. STONE ON THE  
21ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1998.

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A FINANCIAL  
CONTRIBUTION TO THE DOWNTOWN DAYTON  
PARTNERSHIP FOR THE REVITALIZATION OF THE  
DAYTON CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the City of Dayton is recognized as the central city of the Miami Valley area;  
and

WHEREAS, the health and vitality of the central business district of Dayton is a matter of  
importance to the City of Centerville and other communities located in the surrounding Miami  
Valley; and

WHEREAS, to lend financial assistance toward the revitalization of Dayton's central  
business district and to encourage other communities located in the surrounding Miami Valley to  
join in assisting the revitalization of the Dayton central business district, this Council desires to  
make a financial contribution to the Downtown Dayton Partnership.

NOW THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY  
RESOLVES:


Section 1. For the purposes of this resolution and according to the 1990 U.S. Census  
Bureau statistics, this Council finds that the 1990 population of the City of Centerville was 21,082  
persons.

Section 2. This Council hereby approves a financial contribution to the Downtown  
Dayton Partnership in the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) for each City of Centerville resident as so  
identified by the 1990 U.S. Census Bureau statistics; such contribution amount to be Twenty-one  
Thousand Eighty-two Dollars (\$21,082.00). This Council requests that the Downtown Dayton  
Partnership use this contribution for capital improvements, in an identifiable project as approved,  
in advance, by the Centerville City Council.


Section 3. This Council finds that efforts to strengthen the health and stability of the  
central business district of Dayton is a matter of importance for this City, and a healthy and stable  
Dayton central business district will support the public health, safety and general welfare of this  
City.

Section 4. This Council encourages all other political jurisdictions located in the Miami Valley to join Centerville in its support and assistance of revitalization efforts for the Dayton central business district by contributing to the Downtown Dayton Partnership an amount equal to One Dollar (\$1.00) for each of its residents.
