Landscape Management pursuant to specifications prepared by the City; and


WHEREAS, Ever-Green Turf & Landscape was the low and best bidder.

\$11,963.00 for the 1998 season, for a total amount of \$23,801.00.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into



Having read the specifications below, examined the work site and taken into account all addenda issued, the undersigned hereby proposes to furnish all equipment, labor and materials to perform all work, as specified and described in the said specifications, for the following sums:

A. STATEMENT OF ALL BIDDERS:

B. COST INFORMATION AND SPECIFICATIONS (breakdown required).

The bid shall be broken down as follows and the grand total shall be the sum of Bid items #1 through #6.

#1. Mowing, string trimming around all upright objects, and air sweeping sidewalks, brick, asphalt areas, and all hard surfaces once per week or as needed. Cutting height shall be 2 1/2 inches in the spring and remain at 2 1/2 inches until temperatures consistently reach 80 to 85 degrees. At which time the cutting height shall be raised to 3 inches and remain at 3 inches until mid October. In mid October the height shall be lowered to 2 1/2 inches and remain there through the end of the season. (Estimate 30 times.) The direction of cutting shall change with each cutting (i.e., North to South then East to West). There shall be no clumps left on the surface of the lawn after cutting.

#2. Trimming and pruning shall be performed on small specimen trees, shrubs, and ground covers. The pruning shall be for shape and structural health and to preserve the natural growth habit of the specific plant according to standard horticulture practice. Schedule by which pruning shall be performed. Spring blooming plants shall be pruned within 4 weeks after the blooming period is complete. Non blooming deciduous plants shall be pruned prior to leafing out, in the spring. Taxus shall be pruned late May prior to mulching and a second time in September. All other ground covers and plant material shall be pruned as necessary and deemed appropriate for the specific plant variety.

#3. Cutting of new bed lines, weeding and mulching of the beds shall be performed once in the Spring, but not before late May. The total mulch depth shall be 3 inches. A second mulching shall be performed in late September or early October by loosening and turning the existing mulch and applying new mulch, as needed to maintain the depth at 3 inches.

#4. Fall core aeration of entire lawn area.

#5. Perennials shall be cut back in late October after a heavy frost. Ornamental grasses shall be cut back, just prior to Spring green up, approximately mid to late March.

#6. Pruning of shade trees shall include removal of all deadwood, and all structurally unsound limbs. All debris shall be removed from the property. Trees not directly surrounding the buildings, located on the west half of the property, shall be pruned in 1997. Trees on the east half shall be pruned in 1998. (50 trees are to be included each year.)
