## RESOLUTION NO. 22-97 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER JAMES REPPERT ON THE 17th DAY OF HARCH , 1997.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO INSTITUTE AN INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR THE SALES AND BANQUET COORDINATOR OF YANKEE TRACE.

WHEREAS, Centerville operates a banquet center at Yankee Trace Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to encourage as much use of the banquet center by the public as is economically feasible; and

WHEREAS, the operation of the banquet center is an enterprise operation of the City similar to operations of the same nature by private enterprise; and

WHEREAS, it has been the experience of private enterprise that incentives for its sales staff will increase sales and profitability; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager believes that it is in the best interests of the City and its citizens to institute an incentive plan for the Sales and Banquet Coordinator to increase sales and profitability; and

WHEREAS, such an incentive plan was previously authorized by Ordinance 16-96 with any plan being subject to approval by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of this Resolution to approve the specific plan proposed by the City Manager as hereafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE,

## THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to adopt a sales incentive plan whereby the Sales and Banquet Coordinator will receive an amount equal to one eighteenth (1/18) of all service charges or gratuities charged after the passage of this Resolution.

Section 2. For the purposes of this Resolution, the term "banquet" shall mean an event sold from the banquet menu and/or customized menus or meals ordered from the dining room menu and added to a customer's bill. In order to be considered a banquet



1700 ONE DAYTON CENTRE ONE SOUTH MAIN STREET DAYTON, OHIO 45402 sale, an 18% service charge or gratuity must be added to the customer's bill in the ordinary course of business.

A record of all service charges or gratuities shall be kept by the Section 3. Department of Finance. Payment of the amounts due Sales and Banquet Coordinator (hereinafter the "Incentive Bonus") shall be made by the City based upon Department of Finance records for every ninety (90) day period commencing with the date of passage of this Resolution but payable ninety (90) days after the date for which the Incentive Bonus is calculated. In order to be eligible to receive the Incentive Bonus, the Sales and Banquet Coordinator must be in the employ of the City on the date payment is due. Payment of the Incentive Bonus shall be by separate check at the time it is due and normal withholding shall be made except that there shall be no withholding for the employee's share of the Public Employees Retirement System contribution, nor shall the City make an employer contribution because said Incentive Bonus is not eligible for said contributions for the reason that it is not based upon compensation but on the amount of service charges or gratuities collected.
