SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER SUSAN LIENESCH ON THE  
21ST DAY OF JULY, 1997.

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A 1975 WASTE  
PACKER AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND PROVIDING  
FOR THE SALE OF SAID EQUIPMENT TO THE CITY  
OF KETTERING.

WHEREAS, Sections 212.01 and 212.05 of the Centerville Municipal Code provide for the disposal of surplus property of the City, including that having a value of more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), to other units of government or public bodies on a negotiated price basis, and

WHEREAS, the City of Centerville has negotiated the sale of one 1975 International Harvester unit with a 20 cy Dempster Packer, no longer utilized by City personnel, for a purchase price of \$1,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That one 1975 International Harvester unit with a 20 cy Dempster Packer, no longer utilized by the Public Works Department, be declared surplus property.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager do all things necessary to execute the sale of one 1975 International Harvester unit with a 20 cy Dempster Packer to the City of Kettering at a negotiated price of \$1,500.00.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
