EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 23-97 CITY OF CENTERVILLE, OHIO

SPONSORED BY COUNCILMEMBER Brooks Compton ON THE 15TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1997

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO IMPROVE YANKEE TRACE DRIVE, WATERS EDGE DRIVE, LANTERN WAY, GREENSKEEPER WAY AND COURTYARD PLACE BETWEEN CERTAIN TERMINI BY GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING, AND PAVING, CONSTRUCTING STORM AND SANITARY SEWERS, SIDEWALKS, AND WATER MAINS, INSTALLING GAS STREET LIGHTS, AND PROVIDING ALL RELATED WORK AND NECESSARY APPURTENANCES WITH RESPECT TO THOSE IMPROVEMENTS, AND ALSO SOCIAL ROW ROAD, YANKEE TRACE DRIVE, AND YANKEE STREET PIKE AS PROVIDED HEREIN TO THE EXTENT OF AVAILABLE FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the owners of 100% of the lots and lands to be assessed for the improvement described in Section 2 have petitioned this Council for the improvement described herein; now, therefore,

THE MUNICIPALITY OF CENTERVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby declares that an emergency exists affecting the public welfare, in that the improvement authorized by this emergency resolution must be commenced at the earliest possible date in order to start work on the improvement early in the 1998 construction season and thereby enable the improvements to be completed at the earliest possible date in order to provide public streets, drainage facilities, sanitary sewers, water mains, and street lighting, all for the public welfare and safety.

SECTION 2. That it is declared necessary to provide for the following improvements:

1. The improvement of Yankee Trace Drive from Yankee Trace Drive roadway station 12+79.42 (approximately 230 feet north of the intersection of Yankee Trace Drive and

Liberty Crossing) a distance of approximately 3,100 feet to Yankee Trace Drive station 44+00 by grading, draining, curbing, and paving, constructing storm and sanitary sewers, sidewalks, and water mains, and providing all related work and necessary appurtenances thereto.

2. The installation of gas street lights and all related work and necessary appurtenances thereto in the following locations:

On Lantern Way in future Yankee Trace Section 11; approximately 5 lights. On Yankee Trace Drive from roadway station 12+79.24 to roadway station 44+00.00; approximately 22 lights. On Greenskeeper Way, Section 13 (Parcel 19); approximately 7 lights. On Courtyard Place (west), Section 14 (Parcel 16); approximately 8 lights.

- 3. Waters Edge Drive by constructing a brick paver crosswalk at approximately Waters Edge Drive roadway station 30+30.
- 4. Yankee Trace Drive by constructing curbing to provide traffic control islands at approximately Yankee Trace Drive roadway station 9+50 and at roadway station 11+50.
- 5. Optional work to be provided in the following order to the extent of available funds, if any, from the proceeds of the bonds to be issued for the improvement:
- (a) Social Row Road from a point approximately 400 feet east of Yankee Trace Drive easterly approximately 1600 feet by constructing a water main, together with all necessary appurtenances.
- (b) Extending Yankee Trace Drive commencing at the terminus point described in paragraph 1 above by grading, draining, curbing, and paving, constructing storm and sanitary sewers, sidewalks, and water mains, and providing all related work and necessary appurtenances thereto.
- (c) Yankee Street Pike at the intersection of Yankee Street Pike and Winding Green Way by grading and paving to provide a left turn lane.

SECTION 3. That the plans, specifications, profiles and estimate of cost of the improvement, now on file in the office of the Clerk of Council, are approved. The improvement shall be made in accordance with, and the grade of the improvement and of the street shall be the grade as shown on, the plans, specifications and profiles for the improvement, provided that, as authorized by the petition for the improvement, additions to or deductions from the location and number of gas street lights, or constructing a water main in Social Row Road, or extending Yankee Trace Drive, or widening Yankee Street Pike may be provided for at the time of letting contracts for the improvement or during the course of construction which are required in the reasonable judgment of the City Manager so that the annual principal amount of the special assessment and interest thereon will be as close as possible to and not exceed \$660.

SECTION 4. That this Council finds and determines that (i) the improvement is conducive to the public health, convenience and welfare of this City and the inhabitants thereof and (ii) the lots and lands to be assessed as described in Section 4 hereof are specially benefitted by the improvement. This Council further finds and determines that the streets to be improved are so situated in relation to each other that, in order to complete the improvement thereof in the most practical and economical manner, they may, at the option of the City Manager, be improved at the same time, with the same kind of materials and in the same manner and they may, at the option of the City Manager, be treated as a single improvement and included in the same legislation and contract. This Council further finds and determines that the improvement has been petitioned for by the owners of 100% of the lots and lands to be assessed for the improvement. The City Manager's signing of the petition on behalf of the City is hereby ratified, confirmed, and approved.

SECTION 5. The whole cost of the improvement shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits that may result from the improvement upon the following lots and lands, to-wit: the lots and lands described in Exhibit A attached to and made a part of this resolution.

SECTION 6. That the cost of the improvement shall include the cost of preliminary and other surveys, plans, specifications, profiles and estimates and of printing, serving and publishing notices, resolutions and ordinances, the amount of any damages resulting from the improvement and the interest thereon, the costs incurred in connection with the preparation, levy and collection of the special assessments, the cost of purchasing, appropriating, and otherwise acquiring any real estate or interests therein required for the improvement, expenses of legal services including obtaining approving legal opinions, cost of labor and material, and interest on bonds and notes issued in anticipation of the levy and collection of the special assessments, together with all other necessary expenditures.

SECTION 7. That James P. Sullivan is authorized and directed to prepare and file in the office of the Clerk of Council the estimated special assessments of the cost of the improvement described in this resolution. Those estimated special assessments shall be based upon the estimate of cost of the improvement now on file in the office of the Clerk of Council and shall be prepared pursuant to the provisions of this resolution.

SECTION 8. That the special assessments to be levied shall be paid in thirty annual installments of principal and interest, with interest on the unpaid principal amount of each special assessment at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the total of the unpaid special assessments; provided that in accordance with the petition for the improvement there may be certified to and collected by the County up to two additional annual installments of interest only.

SECTION 9. That bonds of the City shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of the annual installments of the special assessments and in an amount equal to the total of the special assessments.

SECTION 10. That this Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 11. That this resolution shall become effective upon its adoption, in accordance with Section 5.05 of the Charter of the City and by reason of Sections 5.05 and 8.11 of the Charter of the City shall not stand repealed as of the 75th day after adoption.


